**PARADE PARTICIPANTS:** Check in & Lineup.

- All parade application forms must be received by **September 4, 2019**. **Late entries will be placed at the end of the parade and may not be judged.**
- All parade participants (**except car show entrants**) must be at the Buttonwillow School located at 42600 Hwy 58 by **8:30 a.m.** to check in and be reviewed by the judges prior to parade starting. **Use of our 2019 Parade theme "Keepin' It Rural!" will be considered when judging the entry.**
- **Check in** will be in front of Auditorium on Buttonwillow Dr.
- Park your vehicles in designated area reserved for participants.
- Floats will be parked on Buttonwillow Drive go in on 3<sup>rd</sup> street to Dunford into the school then on to Buttonwillow Dr.
- The parade starts at 10:00 a.m. **SHARP!**
- Parade route is approximately 1.3 mile long.
- Parade award ceremony will be at 12:00 p.m. at the Park.
- 50% of the judging will be done before the start of the Parade. Judging will begin at 9:15 am. Your entry should be complete and in its assigned location
- **Mayor's Choice Award** – Will be presented before the start of the Parade.
- **GRAND MARSHALL AWARD** – Will be presented before the start of the Parade.
